CANCER SCREENING AND PREVENTION OF CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASSES AND DIABETES IN NATIONAL HEALTH CARE PROGRAMS

(Kotor, 26 – 29 September 2014)

The European Center for Peace and Development (ECPD) University for Peace established by the United Nations has a great pleasure to invite you to take part in the work of this year's ECPD International Specialist School (hereinafter: the School) which is devoted to an extremely important and urgent topic: **preparation and introduction of the national programs of breast, cervical and colorectal cancer screening and prevention of cardiovascular diseases and diabetes.**

This topic was selected at the proposal of the Ministry of Health of Montenegro and policy makers, experts and managers in the health area from the countries in the territory of former Yugoslavia who are aware of the necessity to introduce in their countries, or, if it has already been initiated, to improve the screening and prevention of chronic non-communicable diseases. These diseases are the cause of three of every five deaths in developed countries and the number of saved lives through cancer screening may be counted in thousands per one million inhabitants annually. It has already become unacceptable and considered as an indicator of insufficient overall public health care if certain countries delay the beginning of the organized screening, which would include the entire target population.



The main precondition for successful screening is good organization, which is the reason why most of the lectures in this School will be devoted to this topic. The program is intended for the leading professionals in the ministries of health, health insurance funds and health institutes, especially health centers and public health institutes, but also for health workers who will be carrying out the screening at the level of each institute. The program of the School is entirely based on the European guides for breast, cervical and colorectal cancer screening, as well as for prevention of cardiovascular diseases and diabetes.

The teaching **objectives** of this program are to familiarize participants with the principles, planning, management, conduct, promotion and evaluation of cancer screening, cardiovascular diseases and diabetes, with special emphasis on the integrated approach to their prevention. Presence of a large number of high-ranking representatives of the ministries of health from the countries in the Region will allow discussing possible common approach to prevention of chronic diseases (education, reference centers, etc.).

We believe that during this three-day School participants will obtain sufficient information and knowledge to be able to initiate in their own countries the process of introducing the national cancer, cardiovascular disease and diabetes screening programs.

The School will be opened by the introductory presentation of **Prof. Dr. Miodrag Radunovic**, Minister of Health of the Republic of Montenegro and **Prof. Dr. Slavica Đukić Dejanović**, President of the Health and Family Committee in the National Assembly of the Republic of Serbia.

School **Co-Directors** are **Dr Goran Čerkez**, Assistant Minister of Health of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina and Chair of the SEEHN Executive Committee and **Dr. Simo Vuković**, ECPD UN University for Peace.
